William Steel	Encouraged the use of a disinfectant for typhus before disinfectants were widely used, and researched into the health of needle workers.
James Johnstone	Concerned about the health of Worcester's population and wrote books to educate ordinary people about preventing illness.
Charles Hastings	A member of the British Medical Association who negotiated with the Government about the creation of the NHS
William Strange	Campaigned for greater public health provisions and founded the Provincial Medical and Surgical Association.
