Question 6. When were X-rays discovered?

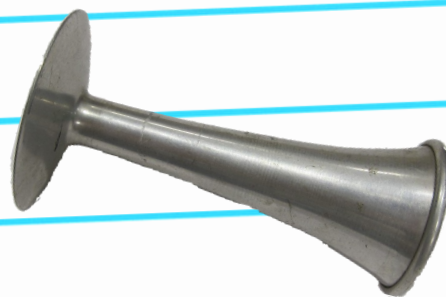
Question 7. In what decade was the first hip replacement done?
